

Typical Pre-Camp Daily Schedule

- 8:45 Counselors arrive and set up for the day, check the fort, Crafty Cave and bathrooms for messes and critters.
- 9:30 Campers arrive
-Parents will drop campers off at the tables where there will be chalk and bubbles.
- 9:30 Morning Campfire
-Campers sit under the tent
-Counselor and campers sing songs and BLITZ.
-Campers get their bodies moving and ready for the day.
- 9:50 Groups break-off
-Counselor will take attendance and make sure everyone has sunscreen on
-Groups play games
- 10:15 Crafty Cave
-The counselor will take the group to the crafty cave and make a fun project which will already be planned.
-Dirt Drawing
-Mud painting
-Leaf people
- 10:45 Hikes, Exploring, Group Games
- 11:00 Lunch
- 11:30 Forts
-Each group goes to the fort.
-Campers work together to make clean the fort, build things, make the fort a magical place
- 12:15 Afternoon Snack
-Groups sit in a circle, have a snack and play a quiet game.
- 12:50 Afternoon Campfire: Groups share about their day, sing songs, perform skits, and do silly dances. PLAN AHEAD OF TIME!
- 1:15-1:30 Parents pick campers from their counselor.
- 1:30 Counselors complete daily cleaning activities.

*This is an example of a typical day. Everyday will be different. You will not go in this order either!

For example:

Camp Days should also include:

- Scavenger hunts
- Nature Activities (looking for animal tracks, making binoculars, going hunting for Hermie the Hippo and Leaf People, exploring camp, etc.)
